News of the GreenNS Match Project

Partners are completing the map on green labour market needs. 20 companies from recycling & waste management, transportation & logistics, vehicle manufacturing and agro food sectors have participated in this process but just 15 will be finally selected.

For instance, a waste management company has identified the profile of industrial waste management technician as the most demanded. This company confirms that the skills to be developed are:

- Verify the characteristics of the waste delivered to the manager as established in the approval forms and Waste Catalogue.
- Establish the valuation or treatment system suitable for each case, and assure that waste is handled in the best possible way.
- Oversee the correct application of valuation and treatment techniques.
- Keep a waste and matter incoming and outgoing log up to date.
- Manage the waste generated by the plant itself.

But the company also specifies that they need that this profile is in charge of managing all documentation specified by regulations with regard to obligations of waste managers with the appropriate official entity.

Partners are also completing the map on green programs and curricula available in each participating region.
